

# BASIC DRAWING CLASSES

## FOR AGES 16 & OLDER

The old master teachers from the past believed that before you could paint or sculpt, you should be able to draw. Drawing is the foundation for everything else in fine art. This class is designed for people who have not taken a basic drawing class before, or those who need to brush up on the basics.

### Required materials:

- 2 White colored pencils
- Pencils: 2 ea. HB, 4 or 6B, and 9B. (woodless preferred)
- 1 ea. white soft rubber eraser, and kneadable eraser
- 9" x 12" sketch book
- 1 small brush for sweeping away eraser stubble
- A manual or portable electric pencil sharpener
- A 12" ruler
