Linda is an accomplished artist living in Placerville. She is a signature member of AWS, NWS & WW. She has been painting for over 20 years after completing art classes at San Jose State Univ. and Cosumnes River College, and studying with several well-known artists (Anita Wolf, Ken Potter, Dale Laitinen, Jan Kunz and others). Linda's art has been shown in Splash 11, 14, 15 & 16 books as well as several watercolor magazines and publications. She likes to capture the extraordinary in the ordinary around us. This one day workshop could be described as **"plan carefully and paint quickly"**. The **"paint quickly"** part is what we will do in this one day we have on the 14th. The **"plan carefully"** part is what the participants will need to do prior to this: prepare at least one accurate, light, drawing on good quality watercolor paper, either 140lb or 300lb cold pressed paper. Linda uses Arches, but if you have a preference then use that. Have a good clear photo for your reference (enlarged would be great), with a full range of dark to light values and a pleasing composition. The subject can be your choice, and something close to a half sheet size would be best.
