Dan Herrera

Dan Herrera is a photographer based in Sacramento, California. Dan uses an elaborate means of image capture, composition, and output that merges 19th century printing techniques with contemporary digital post-production. His work explores how the aesthetics of process can be used as a narrative element.

Dan's exhibition record includes shows in New York, Los Angeles, and numerous Bay Area venues including the De Young Museum in San Francisco, and the Marin Museum of Contemporary Art. His work has been recently published in Submerge Magazine, F-Stop Magazine, Diffusion Magazine, and Juxtapoz. Prof.

Herrera has also been a featured lecturer at the 2014 F295 Symposium, and Cal Poly San Los Obispo.
